PROSSER SCOTTISH FEST

Saturday, June 16th, 2012

You are cordially invited to participate in the 12th Annual Prosser Scottish Fest June 16, 2012 from 9am to 6pm at the Port of Benton Wine and Food Park in Prosser at exit 82 off I-82. Central Washington's only Celtic Heritage event typically serves 1200 attendees.

The Prosser Scottish Fest Committee works to ensure your success. We focus advertising dollars in Central WA, maintain our low admission charge, provide free parking and family friendly activities to entertain the "wee ones" to encourage strong local attendance in spite of the current economy. This year attendees will have local bus service available from 10:30-5pm from winery clusters, local lodging and Historic Downtown. Specific details will be available when they are received from the provider.

We position vendors in prime, high foot traffic locations near the music and athletics (for your enjoyment as well). We try to place vendors in the same location as previous events, unless you indicate otherwise. Fees remain the same. *The cost is \$65.00 per 10'X10' space which includes four gate passes, program description and your web link on our site if you link back to us.* Non-profit vendor rates are available upon request. We give priority to returning vendors and try to avoid product duplication so please provide a detailed description and/or a web link of your products/menu, particularly if this will be your first event with us.

Food vendors - we do reserve the right to negotiate your menu to avoid duplication with fellow vendors. We encourage heritage foodstuffs but not exclusively. Afternoon snack foods are in high demand. If you are a first time applicant please email a menu or web link prior to submitting your fee. Please contact Britt Wilkins, Environmental Health Specialist, Benton-Franklin Health Dept (509) 460-4327 with any specific food handler questions. Temporary food permits require 14 days notice with enforced late fees. Bagged ice will be available for purchase on-site.

Our event is held at the Port of Benton Wine and Food Park on Prosser's east end just off I-82, Exit 82. Parking is free and there is "dry, no hookup" camping on site with access to flush facilities.
