Registration deadline: postmarked May 31, 2016. *Any entries received after this date will be put on a waiting list.*

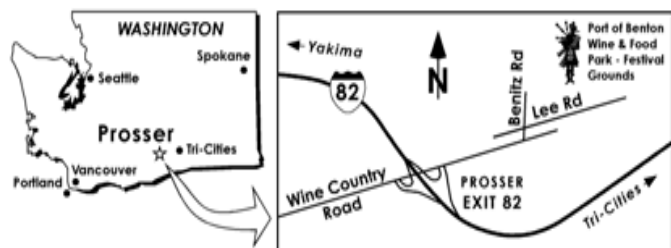
